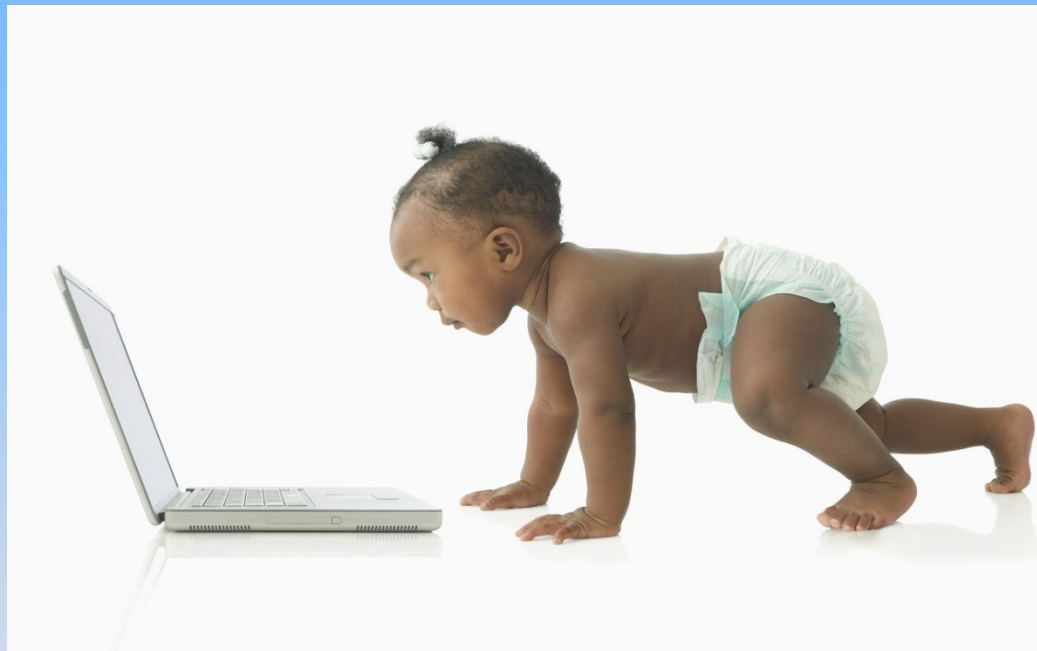

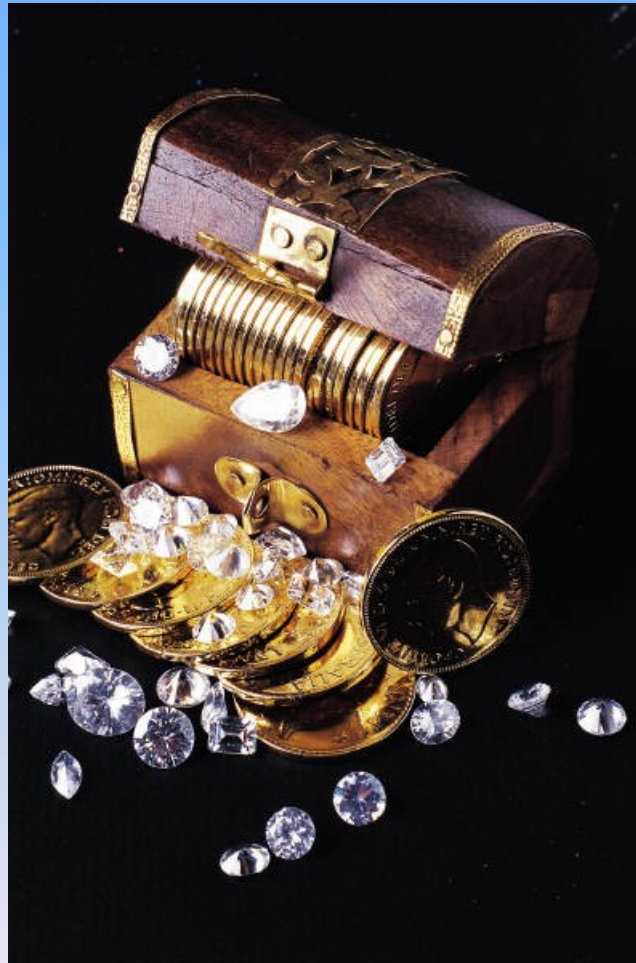

<i>E.g. Trying to build partnerships with our local dentists</i>	<i>E.g. It is difficult to meet with the dentists, they don't seem to know what we really want for our program.</i>	<i>E.g. Arrange for a time to visit each dentist. Use communication strategies when talking to the dentists and invite them to a program event to meet families and staff. Provide information about the program, and Fact Sheets with current information about dental needs of the children.</i>
